DIRECTOR'S NOTE:

Nationalism. Patriotism. These are ephemeral concepts that are often in the eye of the beholder more than being objective and measurable. Henry V is easily the most nationalistic of Shakespeare's plays. It also marks the celebration of the advent of a weapon technology that utterly altered the balance of power throughout Europe - the introduction of the English longbow to the battlefield. Not nearly enough is written about this wildly powerful weapon and the brilliant use the English put it to. Suffice it to say, in watching this play, you are observing a seismic shift in the understanding of warfare. Yet, what of Henry, the man? Assuming the throne at the tender age of 26, the heretofore wastrel heir apparent suddenly had very big shoes to fill, and needed to grow up in a hurry. Shakespeare wastes no time in whisking us off on a journey across the channel, across the various battlefields of France and eventually to London and back to claim the prize of his amazing victories: Katharine of Valois. In doing so, Shakespeare uniquely telescopes time and space, hurtling the audience from place to place over the span of nine years. This play, interestingly, is the only work of Shakespeare's to employ the device of the Chorus, elevating the heroic tale to one of epic proportions, echoing great and timeless Greek works. But, lest we get swept up in the call to battle from the charismatic king, we would do well to remember just how horrible warfare was in the fifteenth century. Brutality, rape, ethnic cleansing and child murder were all accepted tools of war, with no accountability beyond the noblesse oblige of the leaders. It is fascinating that Shakespeare understands this and presents to us a young monarch at the start of the play who has a big chip on his shoulder: easily maneuvered and manipulated and all too easily provoked. He had much to prove. His father had usurped the throne and (many believed) murdered Richard II. In an era when it was commonly held that the sins of the father were passed on to the sons, this worried him enormously. Over the course of the next nine years, we see Henry mature, grow weary of war, and want only peace and marital happiness. He may not have started out as a great, heroic figure, but through the course of the play, we watch him become just that. For this production, I have taken an approach to the Chorus of it being both a voice of the playwright, and the voice(s) within Henry's mind - alternately tormenting him and pricking his pride, stirring him to action, reckless or otherwise. The journey is a powerful one, the text is brilliant, and the actors have worked tirelessly to bring a clear, rich performance to the Montford stage. Please sit back, and enjoy this journey.




